Terms of Reference – April 2017

1. The private-public sector CRP Board will meet twice annually. It is comprised of central London Local Authorities, Business Improvement Districts (BIDs), as well as the GLA, TfL, Network Rail, London & Partners, and Groundwork London (strategic agencies).
2. Board representatives from the Local Authorities will be nominated Cabinet Members. Senior Officers will stand in when required.
3. Board representatives from the BIDs and strategic agencies will be nominated Senior Officers and / or Chief Executives.
4. The CRP Board will have a Co-Chairing arrangement, with a public sector Co-Chair and a private sector Co-Chair.
5. The Public Sector Board Co-Chair is Councillor Wendy Hyde from the City of London Corporation. The private sector Board Co-Chair is Simon Pitkeathley from Camden Town Unltd BID and Euston Town BID.
6. The Board will be consulted on the annual CRP Business Plan, and will approve it at a Board meeting.
7. The Board will facilitate cross-borough and cross-BID discussions on economic development, regeneration and transport topics.
8. The Board will disseminate information on funding opportunities available to central London Local Authorities and BIDs collaboratively.
9. The Board meetings will be supplemented with extra meetings pertinent to specific topics on an as-needed basis, mindful of the time pressures experienced by CRP partners.
10. In between meetings, CRP staff will continue to make themselves available to partners for extra contact they would like via one-to-one meetings, telephone calls and email exchanges. CRP's monthly E-bulletin will also issue information.
11. The Board and its meetings will be serviced by the CRP Director.
12. The Board Terms of Reference will be reviewed regularly.
