LONDON'S EVOLVING LOGISTICS SPACES

Cross River Partnership (CRP) has created an interactive map for Local Authorities and Landowners to advertise under-utilised sites, enabling logistics operators to explore these locations as potential Urban Logistics Hubs and Micro Logistics Hubs across central London. The website was commissioned by the Central London Sub-Regional Transport Partnership, funded by Transport for London.

Urban logistics hubs and micro logistics hubs play an important role in promoting sustainable and efficient freight activity in London. Their use allows goods to be rationalised and distributed via low and zero-emission vehicles for the 'last mile' of the supply chain. This improves air quality, reduces delivery vehicle trips, and decreases traffic congestion on roads.

If you are a site owner interested in finding an operator by advertising your site on the map, please follow these steps:

1

Identify an under-utilised site in your area

2

Contact CRP to add your site or sites to the map

3

CRP will send a template of required site information

4

Once completed, CRP will add the site to the map

5

Operator interest is sent to the site owner when received
