New London Architecture Annual Cycling Summit

Tuesday 4 August 2015 £30 per person 14:00 - 18:00, film screening from 18:00 NLA, The Building Centre, 26 Store Street, London WC1E7BT

NLA's Annual Cycling Summit will hear from the Mayor of London's cycling tsar Andrew Gilligan, as well as speakers from TfL, Construction Industry Cycling Commission, Sustrans, LB Hackney and others on what London is doing to make the capital a safer place for cycling.

This will be followed by a screening of a major new film on cycling, 'Bikes vs Cars', which follows cycling activists across the world as they try to improve cycle safety in their own countries.
