AIR QUALITY IS A SERIOUS HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUE. TAKE THE 10 ACTION CHALLENGE TO REDUCE YOUR IMPACT ON AIR QUALITY AS A BUSINESS.

CONSOLIDATE DELIVERIES

Talk to your business neighbours and see if you have the same suppliers (or supply needs) and work together to consolidate your delivery days and times.



ENCOURAGE STAFF TO WALK OR CYCLE TO WORK





USE CLICK + COLLECT FOR ONE-OFF DELIVERIES

For one-off or personal deliveries to your workplace, consider making <u>click.collect</u> a company policy.

Offering a <u>cycle-to-work scheme</u> is one great way to promote active travel to your workplace, but walking can be just as rewarding. Explore the <u>CRP Clean Air Route Finder</u> to find the least polluted path from work or home. To help encourage cyclists, make sure to offer storage space for cycles and gear.

ASSESS YOUR INDOOR AIR QUALITY

Your employees are spending most of their time indoors, it is important to make sure the air they breath is clean and healthy, too!

REDUCE YOUR SUPPLY CHAIN EMISSIONS
