

Applications open for Clean Air Thames funding (round 1)

This month we launched the <u>Clean Air Thames</u> funding social media campaign! The project, which has received £500,000 from the <u>Mayor of London's Air Quality</u> <u>Fund</u>, aims to reduce polluting emissions on the Tidal Thames by retrofitting 11 inland commercial freight and passenger vessels with post-exhaust treatments. **Deadline for applications - 10th December, 2019.**




