<u>Cross River Partnership</u> (CRP) was joined by industry experts Amy Lamé, London's first ever <u>Night Czar</u>, and Nic Durston, Chief Executive at <u>South Bank BID</u> for an informative discussion on London's cultural and creative industry recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic. They highlighted the history of London's iconic nightlife venues, the night-time sector's vital importance to local community cohesion, and the economic and environmental impacts that further restrictions will have on a local and national scale. In addition, CRP Director -Susannah Wilks, gave an overview of the new <u>Centre for London</u> led research project, <u>Lighting London</u>, which will explore opportunities around sustainability, equity, and well-being, and what role lighting can play in supporting cultural and economic vitality in urban centres.
