A QUICK GUIDE OF RULES FOR BUSINESSES

PUBS, BARS & RESTAURANTS

- Pubs and bars can stay open if offering meals
- Last call is at 10pm, and venues to close at 11pm
- Delivery can stay open later

RETAIL SHOPS

- All non-essential retail shops can open
- Must follow <u>Covid-</u> <u>secure guidelines</u>
- All venues to close by 11pm

OFFICES

- Anyone who can work from home should still do so
- Office spaces that are open must follow <u>Covid-secure</u> guidelines for offices

BARBERS & SALONS

- Personal care venues are allowed to open
- Venues must be compliant with Covid-secure guidelines for close contact services

HOTELS & ACCOMODATION

- Hotels, holiday lets and guesthouses may open
- Must ensure physical distancing rules can be followed
- Follow the Covidsecure <u>guidelines</u> <u>for accommodations</u>

INDOOR ENTERTAINMENT

- Casinos, theatres, cinemas and sports stadia may open
- Capacity is limited to 50% or 1,000 people indoors
- Events must start before 10pm, can finish past 11pm

SPORTS & EXERCISE

- Gyms and fitness studios may open but different households may not interact indoors
- Organised activities for under-18s and disabled people can continue
