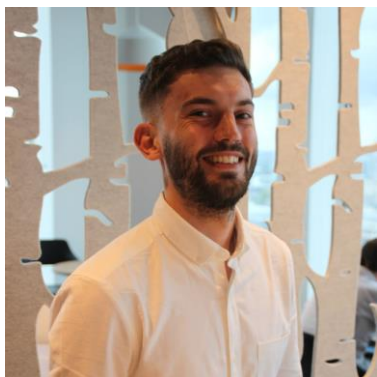

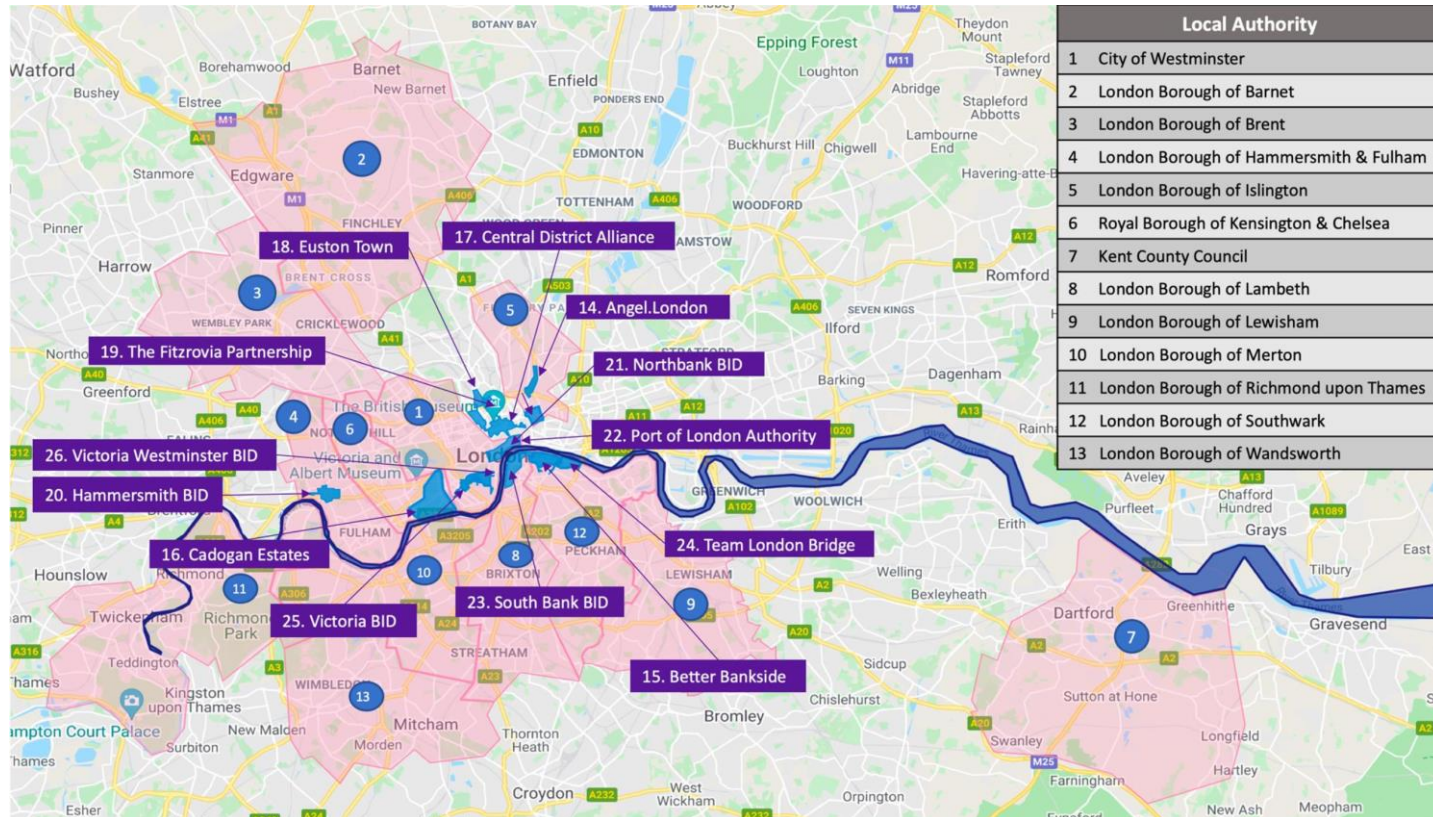

CAV4 Project Recap



Clean Air Villages 4 (CAV4) is a [Defra](#) funded AQ project led by [Westminster City Council](#) in collaboration with 26 project partners to improve the air quality across different London 'villages', where both air pollution and population density levels are high.

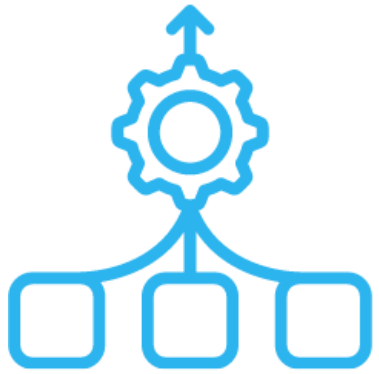
£700,000 was granted to CRP (the largest portion), with additional match funding from **26** project partners of **£520,000**.

26 Partners: 13 Local Authorities, 11 Business Improvement Districts, Cadogan Estates and the Port of London Authority.

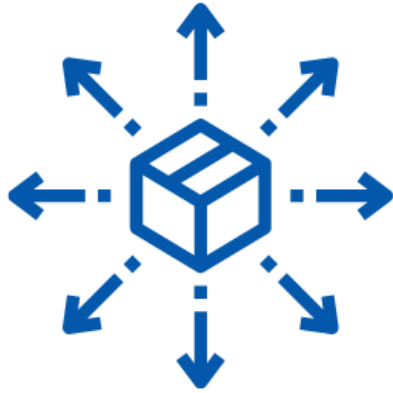
Project length: **1st April 2021 to 30th June 2022.**

CAV4 will build on the successes of the award winning [CAV1](#) programme, as well as [CAV2](#) and [CAV3](#), which all focused on interventions to support businesses, communities and hospitals. CAV4 aims to deliver ambitious **Freight Solutions for a Clean Air business recovery from COVID-19**.

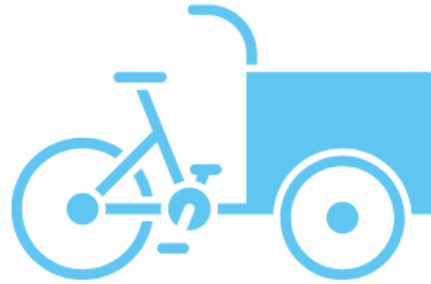

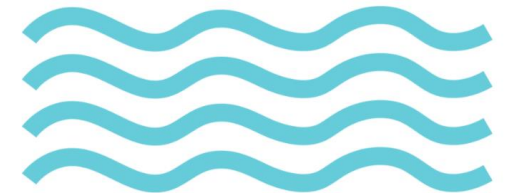
Consolidation

Progress:

- **Zero emission vehicles:** Explore, trial and monitor EVs from Dartford Consolidation Centre, into central London and encourage vehicle mode switch.
- **River freight trial:** Supporting monitoring for the CEVA Logistics/GSTT river freight trial. Exploring expansion to new providers and further along the river with Hammersmith BID and Wandsworth.
- **Consolidation of suppliers:** producing recommendations for preferred suppliers, in order to reduce vehicle movements and save costs with Cadogan, Euston Town BID and Central District Alliance.

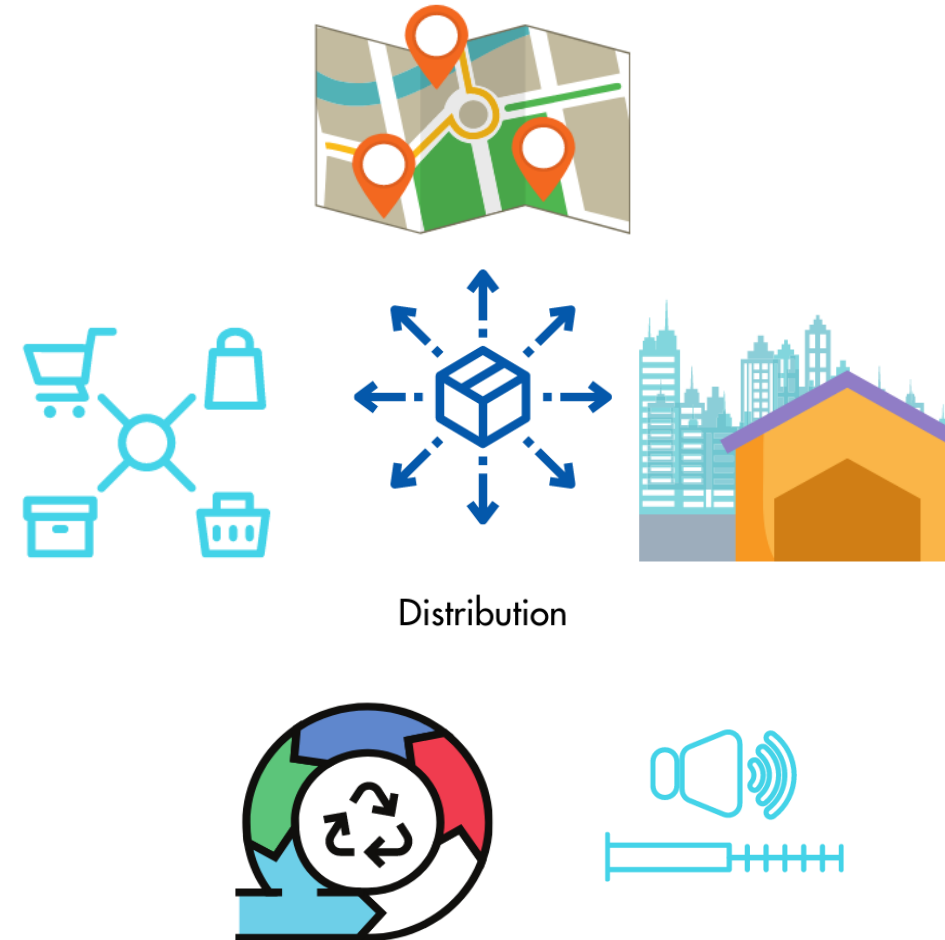

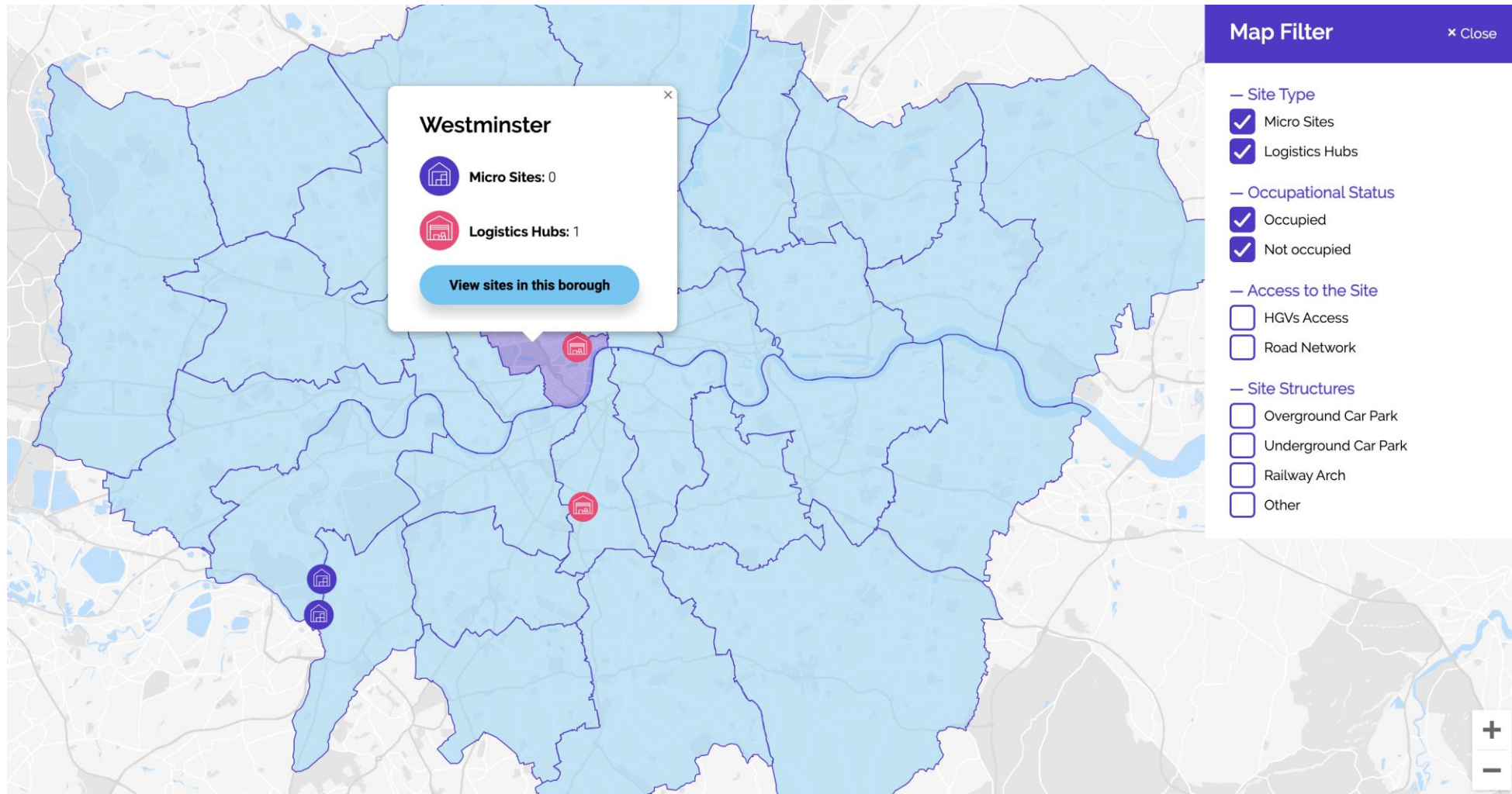
Progress:

- **Expansion of Urban Logistics Map**
- **Sustainable Freight hub-** Identifying demand for hubs both north and south of the river, couple of hubs identified with operators.
- **Digital Loading Bay monitoring-** 2 x partners taking part and monitoring procured.
- **Circular Economy Trial** (e.g. Reverse logistics)- Working with Angel BID and Islington on a circular economy incorporating high street businesses and market traders.

Progress:

- **Electric Vehicles:**
 - Exploring shared EV schemes with Richmond and Barnet
 - Procurement of telematic dongles to assist business case for switching to EVs
- **Cargo Bikes:**
 - Developing trials in Brent & Merton
 - Engagement / promotion of schemes in Northbank BID and Richmond
- **River Freight Infrastructure:**
 - Finalising details of river freight infrastructure feasibility study (potential to retrofit a passenger pier for freight with learnings feeding into this)
- **Rail / Tube Freight:**
 - Identifying key players to help feed into / define feasibility study
- **Walking Freight:**
 - Facilitating focus group to identify challenges / opportunities for walking freight
