As part of the Defra-funded Clean Air Villages 3 programme, Cross River Partnership (CRP) hosted a series of online, interactive LiveShare workshops from June to December 2020. The aim of these LiveShares was to promote behaviour change to improve local air quality.

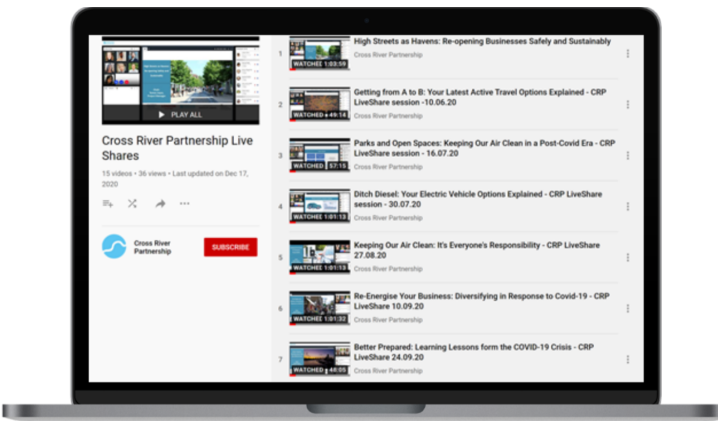
CRP's LiveShares brought together industry experts to present, explain and discuss air quality issues and solutions via an interactive forum, to a varied audience from the public, private and third sectors.

To further facilitate knowledge sharing and to promote practical guidance, a toolkit was published to complement each LiveShare (left).
