

LONDON'S ULTRA-LOW EMISSION ZONE EXPANSION

- Get advice:

- Check with suppliers: Ask your suppliers how they plan to mitigate the impact of the cost of ULEZ to ensure that costs will be not be passed on to you.
- **Consolidate with your** neighbours:

Larger orders may be cheaper due to economies of scale. Ask a local business you know if you could share any suppliers, or even customers, for deliveries.

- Summarising your cargo bike options:
 - CRP has produced guidance showing the pros and cons of <u>different cargo bike options;</u> from purchasing the right one, to using a courier service or setting up a shared cargo bike for businesses.

Purchasing or leasing a cargo bike:

There are many sources of funding and grants available for businesses considering buying their own cargo bike – from free loan schemes to discounts on the cost of the bike. Organisations that promote free cargo bike trials or loans include local authorities, Sustrans, Energy Saving Trust, Zero Emission Network and many more.

Case studies:

As part of the Defra-funded Clean Air Villages project, CRP has worked with many different types of businesses who have switched their long-term delivery methods to cargo bikes, including:

- <u>Vehicle Scrappage Scheme</u> is available for small businesses
- Other <u>Government incentives</u>
- Cheaper to maintain and park
- Cheaper to charge up to a 1/4 or less of what a traditional petrol or diesel car might cost
- Compliance with <u>ULEZ</u> / <u>LEZ</u> may be eligible for a <u>discount from</u> **Congestion Charge**
