

KEY FACTS

Walking freight is well suited to high volume, low weight goods, which includes scope for a high proporition of personal deliveries. Walking freight benefits include up to 10% reduction in logistics kilometres driven in the Central Activities Zone, removing more than 20 million kilometres per year.





Vision Zero is a road safety policy first adopted in Sweden in 1997. The long-term goal of Vision Zero, as the name suggests, is that noone is killed or seriously injured as a consequence of traffic collisions within the road transport system.

Central District Alliance (CDA)'s strategic interventions include both long term projects and incremental upgrades. Each is tailored to fit its purpose and the character of its location and are all contained in CDA's Public Realm Development Plan.
