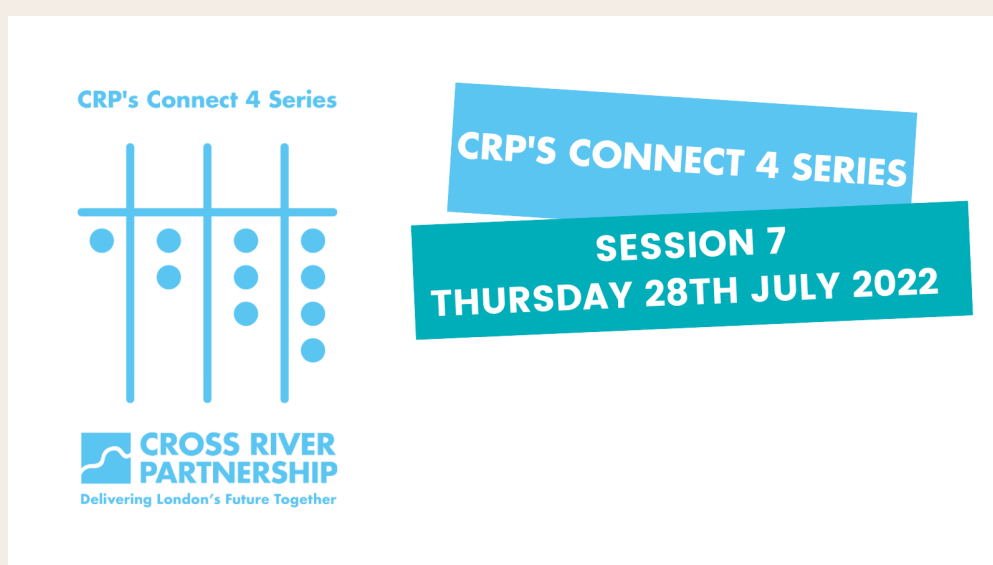

KEY FACTS

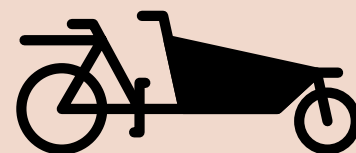
