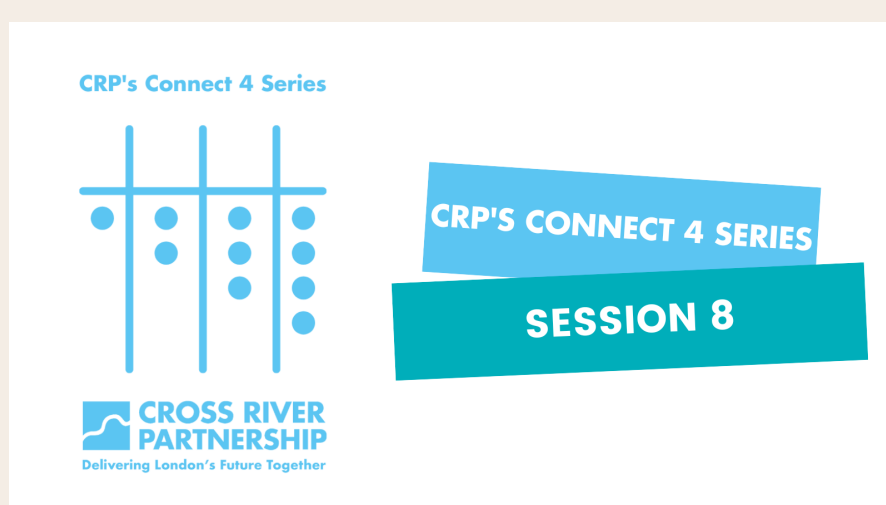

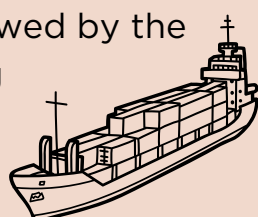

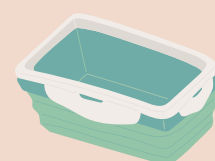


KEY FACTS

Of the navigable waterways, the Thames handled the most domestic traffic in the UK, accounting for over half (58%) of all goods moved by inland waterway in 2020. In terms of goods lifted, the River Thames handled around 20.9 million tonnes of freight, 50% of all total traffic on UK waterways, followed by the River Forth handling 6.5 million tonnes or 16%.



The UK generates 11 billion pieces of packaging waste from lunch-on-the-go each year. Junee is on a mission to replace 25 million single-use takeaway containers by 2025.



SMEs (small and medium-sized enterprises) account for 99.9% of the business population (5.6 million businesses).
