

Join us for <u>Cross River Partnership</u>'s next event, <u>CRP Conversations, Event 3 – Innovative</u> <u>Transport Decarbonisation</u>. This Conversation will explore air quality and innovation across the UK.

Dr Gary Fuller (<u>Imperial College London</u>), Eleanor Marshall (<u>Innovate UK KTN</u>) and Dan Fredriksson (<u>Great British Railways Transition Team</u>) will be presenting on air quality and what's needed to fix the problem, with a focus on innovation.

- Dr Gary Fuller will be focusing on how government, policy makers and innovators need to join together de-carbonisation, air quality and climate change policies, to take effective action on the situation.
- Eleanor Marshall will be presenting on <u>Innovate UK KTN's</u> role in decarbonising transport infrastructure across the UK alongside government, including in facilitating central government competitions for transport decarbonisation 2050 goals.
- Dan Fredriksson will be launching the Rail Freight Report funded by Impact on Urban Health. Undertaken by transport consultants Steer within CRP's Clean Air Freight programme, the report shows the potential for delivering more freight into London via rail, thereby reducing polluting road traffic.

The CRP Board meeting took place on Thursday 9th March 2023.

It was extremely well-attended with representation from 21 public and private bodies in central London. Huge thanks to all of <u>CRP's partners</u> for your ongoing support.

CRP was very pleased to welcome <u>Harley Street BID</u> onto the Board.

CRP was also very pleased to hear <u>Dan Fredriksson</u> of the <u>Great British Railways</u> <u>Transition Team</u> (GBRTT) presenting on the opportunity presented by Waterloo Station for handling freight alongside passengers as part of the <u>Network Rail</u> and <u>London Borough of</u> <u>Lambeth</u> Waterloo Station Master Planning exercise. The CRP Board signed off CRP's draft Annual Report and Business Plan, which will be launched this Thursday 30th March 2023.

#### London Light Freight River Trial



CRP's London Light Freight River Trial has come to an end after 4 successful weeks!

The trial was London's first daily, multi-supplier, river freight trial along the Thames and was a collaboration between the Port of London Authority, Lyreco UK & Ireland, Speedy Services, Thames Clippers Logistics, Grid Smarter Cities and Pedal Me.

The trial focused on the next day delivery market and also incorporated return deliveries, highlighting how the river can enable fast, efficient and consistent deliveries in a more sustainable way.

Fiona Coull, Programme Manager, CRP, said:

"It has been brilliant to work with so many partners on the London Light Freight River Trial to get more freight into central London by river rather than by road. Incorporating return deliveries even further highlights how effective the river can be for just-in-time deliveries, as well as the opportunity it provides to help businesses reduce their carbon footprint and improve congestion and air quality."

## Clean Air Logistics for London - March Update



Over the past month, the CRP <u>team</u> has been working closely with partners to deliver our <u>Defra</u>-funded <u>Clean Air Logistics for London</u> (CALL) programme. This included an exciting trip to the <u>Cory</u> Waste Transfer Station, and the launch of <u>CRP's London Light Freight</u> <u>River Trial</u>.

As part of our most recent CALL Steering Group Meeting, CRP and partners visited the <u>Cory</u> Waste Transfer Station at Smugglers Wharf. The station specialises in transporting, loading, unloading, and processing waste to and from the river. The visit was extremely interesting and showed partners how the process works, as well as how vital the river is to avoiding truckloads of recyclable and non-recyclable material to be transported on our roads.

CRP also launched the London Light Freight River Trial; London's first daily, multi-supplier, river freight trial along the Thames.
