**Clean Air Logistics for London - Outputs** 

- Pier Adaptions & Facilities
  - Supported PLA to procure an additional pontoon to create London's first dedicated freight pier
  - Completed the 'E-cargo Bike Pier Design Guidance'
  - Completed the installation of a sustainable deliveries hub near Chelsea Harbour Pier
  - Installed 20 parcel lockers across Lewisham
  - Installed parcel locker at the Greenland Surrey Quays
    Dock Offices

#### **Clean Air Logistics for London - Outputs**


- Vessels
  - Completed retrofit of Alb-E, converting from diesel powered engine to electric motor
  - Baselined emissions savings by Alb-E switching from diesel to electric power
  - Completed time-lapse video capturing retrofit
  - Completed deep-dive report sharing lessons learned
- EV Charging & Infrastructure
  - Supported Lambeth to install chargepoints in Streatham and Norwood
  - Engaged Norwood businesses to encourage behaviour change and use of shared EVs
  - Published snapshot with overview of charge points and shared EV scheme
  - Supported installation of first 10 chargepoints of 40 chargepoints in ZEVHub charging facility in Southwark.





**Clean Air Logistics for London - Outputs** 

- River Trials & Onward Journeys
  - Delivered the London Light Freight River Trial
    - Stakeholder event in March 2023
    - Articles published in various media outlets
  - Published Deep Dive report with impacts of project and lessons learned
  - Worked with LB Southwark to trial 2 virtual loading bays using Kerb
  - Reinstated original CAV4 / CALL river freight trial on a monthly basis





**Clean Air Logistics for London - Outputs** 

- Micro Hub Development & Transport Analysis
  - Commenced "The London Light Freight Walking Trial" in May, using e-walkers to support last-mile deliveries in Fitzrovia
  - Held launch in June including demo of e-walker
  - Published snapshot describing trial
  - Delivered 2 e-bikes to LB Islington as part of OurBike schemes in borough
  - Launched 6-month micrologistics trial hub in Pimlico
  - Launched similar hub in Southside Shopping Centre
  - Ran urban logistics hub workshop for CALL partners

- Communications & Media

  - Research linking benefits of Clean Air Route
    Finder to active travel deliveries
  - Summer stakeholder event in June marking completion of CALL and start of Smarter Greener Logistics





#### Waterloo Freight Hub

- Completed commissioned work exploring Waterloo Station as a freight hub including:
  - A tool to model the economic, environmental and social impacts it of a logistics hub at the Station
  - A research report on the impacts of using the Station's underutilised undercrofts
  - An express rail freight market analysis to understand the potential of the express rail freight market by 2050, especially in London.
  - A train path capacity plan report to identify the times available on the current rail network when a rail freight service could be delivered.
  - Discussed in detail at next CRP Conversations on 11
    October







#### **Smarter Greener Logistics**

#### • Progress to date

- Nine workstreams decided
  - 1. Waterloo Freight Hub
  - 2. Urban Logistics Hubs
  - 3. Kerbside management
  - 4. Click & collect
  - 5. Shared electric vehicle schemes
  - 6. Cargo bike delivery schemes
  - 7. Logistics sector support
  - 8. Air quality & noise monitoring
  - 9. Project-wide interventions
- Partner Project Forms and follow up meetings completed
- First SGL taskforce meeting held in August





#### **EC Business Improvement District Collaboration: Social Media**

- Collaborated with EC BID on strategic communications
- Delivered a successful social media campaign of 72 posts across 3 months and 2 social media platforms (LinkedIn and Twitter)
- 3 themes: Green Spaces, Iconic Buildings and Places, Hospitality & Retail
- Promoted the EC BID area throughout the summer holidays, including exciting new restaurants, new walking maps and famous landmarks








#### **Clean Air Freight**

- CRP has completed its Clean Air Freight programme, which included the Brixton Logistics Trial and Rail Freight Feasibility Study, <u>On Track for Sustainable</u> Logistics
- The Brixton Logistics Trial showed significant air quality improvements from a consolidation centre focussed on a local area, with independent transport consultants estimating savings of:
  - $\circ~$  109 kg of CO2
  - $\circ~75~g~of~NOx$
  - $\circ$  27 g of PM10
- CRP will be developing the potential for a Waterloo Freight Hub in the Smarter Greener Logistics programme, after it's potential was identified in the <u>On Track for Sustainable Logistics</u> report

### CRP Outputs, Q3 - Q4 23/24 : Smarter Greener Logistics

By this point CRP's Smarter Greener Logistics Programme will be in full swing with the following initiatives / trials underway

- Pimlico, Westminster Hub 3 month extension
  - WCC is the main delivery partner, however the 10-mile delivery radius captures 18 London boroughs including Wandsworth, Lambeth, Southwark, City of London, Hammersmith & Fulham and more
- Southside, Wandsworth Shopping Centre Hub fully operational
  - Wandsworth is the main delivery partner, but again we expect wider areas to be impacted positively
- Waterloo, road fed freight hub trial underway
  - Our main partners in this trial will include Lambeth and Southwark, however we expect a wider area of London to be serviced by the hub






### CRP Outputs, Q3 - Q4 23/24 : Smarter Greener Logistics

- Lambeth Freight Hub trial operational
  - This will be delivered with Lambeth but again we expect wider impacts across CRP partner areas
- Kerbside Management Virtual Loading Bay Trial finalised and underway
  - This will likely include locations in Southwark, Westminster, Camden, Hammersmith & Fulham, Ealing and Lewisham, however the trial is open to all SGL partners
- IKEA river freight trial in progress
  - This will impact several partner areas through the removal of vehicles from Dartford to Central London
- Minimum 2 Our Bike Schemes Implemented
  - These will be implemented in Islington and Wandsworth and / or Richmond
- Parcel locker expansion ongoing
  - Working with Camden, Lewisham and Southwark
- Walking Freight Trial impacts realised in Camden

We will also be creating resources and communication materials to share any learnings associated with the trials. There will also be frequent updates on impacts / outcomes associated with the above schemes and other SGL Programme developments.



## CRP Outputs, Q3 - Q4 23/24 : Harley Street BID Data **Analysis & Monitoring Services**



The Harley Street BID is a newly established Business Improvement District. Consequently, understanding traffic counts, near miss data and emissions in the area will be important to encourage behaviour change and to inform public realm improvements. CRP will be providing Monitoring and Data Analysis services to support this including:

- VivaCity Monitoring Sensors
- Traffic Count Analysis
- Active Travel Count Analysis
- Near Miss Reporting
- Air Quality Modelling
- Space and Behaviour Analysis
- Speed Analysis
- Directionality Mapping




## CRP Outputs, Q3 - Q4 23/24 : South Bank BID Data Analysis & Monitoring Services

CRP will be continuing to provide data analysis and monitoring services for the South Bank BID throughout this period. This includes providing:

- VivaCity Monitoring Sensors
- Traffic Count Analysis
- Active Travel Count Analysis
- Air Quality Modelling

CRP has been providing data analysis and monitoring services for South Bank BID for the past 3 years.







#### CRP Planned Work, Q3 - Q4 2023/24

#### **Just Streets**

- A 4-year Horizon 2020 programme to encourage Streets as a space for all, rather than a thoroughfare for vehicles
  - Physical interventions to enable more use of outdoor space, improving experience for all, particularly women, LGBTQ+, elderly, physically/mentally disabled
  - Seating, lighting, etc.
  - Working with other groups on mobility projects
  - Data collection of roads accident
  - Changing the narrative from vulnerable to valuable, closed streets to open spaces
- 17-country consortium including three UK partners (WCC-CRP, University of Westminster, LB Southwark)
- CRP to deliver
  - $\circ~$  3 new street installations
  - 50% reduced road accidents over Just Streets lifetime
  - 5 social media campaigns promoting inclusive/active mobility










### **Smarter Greener Logistics 2 Collaborative Defra Bid**

SGL2 is a mainly revenue spending project that will implement a range of Logistics Workstreams to clean up London's air, to involve:

- Smarter Freight Hub Inter-Changes.
- Greener Road Freight.
- Greener Rail Freight.
- Greener Water Freight.
- Policy-influencing to support Sustainable Logistics.
- Sustainable Logistics supporting the re-design of High Streets.
- Communications to raise awareness.
- Monitoring to capture benefits.
