A Win for Wandsworth: CRP's New Micro Logistics Hub Trial



CRP has recently launched its latest <u>six-month micro logistics hub trial</u> in the Southside Shopping Centre <u>Car Park</u> in the <u>London Borough of Wandsworth</u>.

Funded by <u>Defra</u> in partnership with the <u>London Borough of Wandsworth</u>, this CRP trial is supporting low-emission last-mile deliveries in the London Borough of Wandsworth and surrounding areas. This initiative is funded by CRP's <u>Clean Air Logistics for London</u> and <u>Smarter Greener Logistics</u> programmes. Deliveries are also operating to the London Boroughs of <u>Richmond upon Thames</u> and <u>Merton</u> across the tri-borough area.

The hub has been created by sustainable logistics experts <u>Decarbon Logistics Solutions</u> in partnership with <u>APCOA Parking (UK) Limited</u>, and deliveries will be carried out by low-emission courier <u>Delivery Mates</u>. Read the official <u>press release</u> on the CRP website.

Marking World Rivers Day




