Exciting Pimlico Hub Trial Update!



Together with <u>Westminster City Council</u>, we are excited to announce that after a successful 9-month trial period, the low-emission courier <u>Delivery Mates</u> and <u>Q-Park</u> have come to an agreement and will continue to independently operate from the Pimlico micro logistics hub for a minimum of 12 months.

The CRP and WCC-funded trial, which aimed to support low-emission last-mile deliveries in the City of Westminster, was supported by <u>Decarbon Logistics Solutions</u>, and carried out

by <u>Delivery Mates</u> low-emission couriers. The project was part of the <u>Defra-funded Clean Air Logistics for London</u> (CALL) and <u>Smarter Greener Logistics</u> (SGL) programmes.

Based in the Q-Park Pimlico parking facility, the hub receives parcels from an electric van and then distributes them by electric cargo bikes in the City of Westminster and surrounding areas.

Here are some of the achievements we've delivered this month through collaborative and partnership working:

- CRP has been working closely with <u>GRID Smarter Cities</u>, the London Boroughs of <u>Camden</u>, <u>Lambeth</u> and <u>Richmond</u>, and the <u>City of London Corporation</u> to develop a Virtual Loading Bay trial utilising digital kerbside management technology. This month saw a key milestone achieved with all the partners shortlisting two locations to take forward for the trial.

Just Streets Launches in Turin



CRP was delighted to attend the <u>Just Streets</u> kick-off meeting last week in Turin, Italy. We joined more than 60 people from 17 countries to begin developing a new vision of spatial justice where streets become a public space for all.

We are looking forward to participating in this <u>Horizon Europe</u> project, coordinated by <u>Fondazione LINKS</u>. Just Streets aims to transform cities' car-centric mobility narratives by promoting walking, cycling and sustainable modes of mobility, as well as making streets more people-friendly.

Marginalised social groups, previously underrepresented in mobility infrastructure decision-making, will be a core focus, allowing Just Streets to create highly valuable know-how, critical in creating better, more just, and sustainable cities for all citizens.

As part of the Just Streets project, CRP plans to implement three street-level solutions in London.
