







This March, we are celebrating 30 Years of Delivering Innovative Trials here at Cross River Partnership (CRP).

CRP is a test bed for designing and delivering innovative pilot projects with and for its partners, all of which are aimed at making London the best possible place it can be.

Trial highlights over recent years include:

- Delivering two River Freight pilots along the River Thames with the <u>Port of London</u> <u>Authority</u> and other partners
- Delivering micro-logistics hub trials in Pimlico, <u>Westminster</u> and <u>Wandsworth</u>
- Trialling Walking Freight in The Fitzrovia Partnership area of Camden
- Trialling Virtual Loading Bays in boroughs including Southwark and Lambeth
- Trialling cargo bikes schemes across various areas of London, including <u>Islington</u> and <u>Wandsworth</u>

Obtaining data, insights and learning through these trials helps to support and inform adoption of similar sustainability initiatives across London and further afield!

# 2 Virtual Loading Bays are now live in the London Borough of Lambeth



CRP are excited to announce that 2 <u>Virtual Loading Bays</u> are now live in the London Borough of Lambeth! The 2 Virtual Loading Bays are located along The Cut, Waterloo and will be available to book 24 hours per day, free of charge, for a trial period of 6 months.

The Virtual Loading Bays form part of CRP's Kerbside Management Trial and are being delivered in partnership between <u>London Borough of Lambeth</u>, <u>Grid Smarter Cities</u> and <u>Cross River Partnership</u>. The trial uses Grid's Virtual Loading Bay technology to dynamically manage the kerbside and aims to improve congestion and air quality in the local area.

Now operated independently by <u>Delivery Mates</u> for another year, the hub continues to make progress in sustainable last-mile deliveries in the City of Westminster and beyond.

Edward Cox, Business Development & Operations Manager at <u>Decarbon Logistics</u> <u>Solutions</u>, and Kevin Savage, COO at Delivery Mates, also joined the tour, offering firsthand insights and answering the team's questions. The visit showcased the success of the hub in intercepting LGV and HGV vehicle miles, reducing congestion, and improving local air quality.
