CRP Secures European Funding



CRP is really pleased to have secured £0.5 million of $\underline{\text{Horizon Europe}}$ funding, for the first time since Brexit occurred!

The project, called <u>JUST STREETS</u>, encompasses a team of 30 partners from 17 countries, including 12 cities representing more than 4.5 million citizens.

JUST STREETS will tackle fair and sustainable travel and use of streets and public spaces. In London CRP will deliver three demonstrator interventions with its CRP partners – watch this space for further details about how to get involved!

Westminster City Council has signed the Consortium Agreement on behalf of CRP, as CRP's legal entity.

CRP is continuing to finalise arrangements with $\underline{\sf UKRI}_{,}$ the European Commission's appointed UK agency.

SGL April Update – Moving Towards Delivery



The start of the new financial year marks the half way point for CRP's <u>Smarter Greener Logistics</u> (SGL) programme! April marks a key milestone where our focus shifts from project development to project delivery.

Consequently, this month has seen the start of three exciting initiatives as part of the SGL programme:

- CRP has been working with <u>London Borough of Tower Hamlets</u> and <u>City Soil Lab</u> to pilot a circular waste scheme in and around Bethnal Green.
- This month we also had the kick off for our London Wide Freight Flow Study. CRP has commissioned the consultants <u>Steer</u> to undertake the research.
- This month we also installed air quality and noise monitors in collaboration with <u>London Borough of Merton</u> and <u>Willow Lane BID</u>, enabling a 6-month monitoring project in the BID area.
