

Two Virtual Loading Bays Launch in London Borough of Richmond



CRP are excited to announce that 2 <u>Virtual Loading Bays</u> are now live in the London Borough of Richmond. The 2 Virtual Loading Bays are located in Sheen Lane, Mortlake

and The Quadrant, Richmond and will be available to book, free of charge, for the trial period to the end of 2024.

Virtual Loading Bays are dedicated spaces that can be pre-booked to deliver goods by participating operators with the Grid Kerb Delivery booking application.

The Virtual Loading Bays form part of CRP's <u>Defra</u>-funded Kerbside Management Trial and are being delivered in partnership between <u>London Borough of Richmond</u>, <u>Grid Smarter</u> <u>Cities</u> and <u>Cross River Partnership</u>. The trial uses Grid's Virtual Loading Bay technology to dynamically manage the kerbside and aims to improve congestion and air quality in the local area.

CRP Partners with EMSOL for Wandle Way Sustainability Project



CRP have partnered with <u>EMSOL</u>, a leading provider of real-time emissions monitoring and analytics solutions, and <u>London Borough of Merton</u>, to address the pressing issue of pollution and dust emissions from an industrial estate in the Wandle Way area of Mitcham.

The six-month project will leverage EMSOL's advanced emissions monitoring technology to assess the severity of the air quality and noise pollution problem in Wandle Way.

The project has been funded through CRP's <u>Defra</u>-funded <u>Smarter Greener Logistics</u> (SGL) programme.

Seeking New Operator for Wandsworth Micro Logistics Hub



In August 2023, CRP launched a six-month micro logistics hub trial in the <u>Southside</u> <u>Shopping Centre Car Park</u>, managed by <u>APCOA</u>, in the <u>London Borough of Wandsworth</u>. Delivered through CRP's <u>Defra</u>-funded <u>Clean Air Logistics for London</u> and <u>Smarter</u> <u>Greener Logistics</u> programmes, the hub, managed by <u>Decarbon Logistics Solutions</u>, aimed to support low-emission last-mile deliveries.

During the trial, fresh flowers were delivered from outside London overnight by e-van, then sorted at the hub before being distributed. Read the hub case study <u>here</u>.

Since concluding in February, the courier has been renewing their license on a monthly basis while evaluating long-term use of the hub.
