CRP are trialling Virtual Loading Bays (VLBs) across London and are looking for logistics operators to get involved!

VLB's are dedicated spaces at the kerbside that can be pre-booked by participating operators to make deliveries more efficient, safe and sustainable whilst improving congestion and air quality in the local area.

We've completed several trials as part of our [Defra](#) funded [Smarter Greener Logistics \(SGL\)](#) Programme and have also been out and about promoting the use of these fabulous last mile logistics tools to businesses and communities across London!

For example, this month we have:

- Launched 3 OurBike's in Earlsfield, Holloway Road and Archway
- Completed the [City Soil Lab](#) Pre-Pilot which used cargo bikes to collect business food waste and convert it to compost / soil

July saw the launch of the [results of The Healthy Streets Scorecard](#), which ranks London Boroughs on how healthy their streets are according to ten healthy streets indicators.

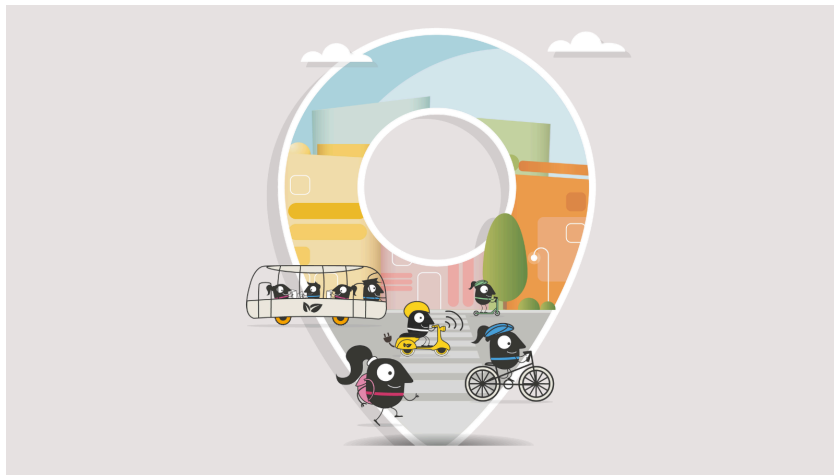
