CRP led a fun and informative site visit, showcasing various city greening, sustainable transport and healthy streets initiatives delivered with support from <u>Mayor of London</u>.



## 2 Virtual Loading Bays are now live in the London Borough of Camden



<u>Cross River Partnership</u> (CRP) is excited to announce that 2 <u>Virtual Loading Bays</u> are now live in the <u>London Borough of Camden</u>. The 2 Virtual Loading Bays are located on Morwell Street and Kentish Town Road and will be available to book, free of charge, until the end of 2024.

Virtual Loading Bays are dedicated spaces at the kerbside that can be pre-booked by participating operators to load and unload goods using the Grid Kerb booking platform. VLBs aim to make deliveries more efficient, sustainable and improve congestion and air quality in the local area.

The Virtual Loading Bays form part of CRP's <u>Defra</u>-funded Kerbside Management Trial and are being delivered in partnership between <u>London Borough of Camden</u>, <u>Grid Smarter Cities</u> and <u>Cross River Partnership</u>.

Monitoring is an essential part of CRP's <u>Smarter Greener Logistics (SGL)</u> Programme as it enables us to understand the impacts of the various interventions and trials we have implemented

Now that we're entering the final few months of the programme, here are some of the insights our monitoring has shown us so far:

- 2,100kg of food waste has been diverted from incineration because of the City Soil Lab pilot
- 12,135 packages were delivered as part of The London Light Freight Walking Trial
- 9 different operators have taken part in our Digital Kerbside Management Trial so far
