
















Just Streets - Overview

CRP secured £0.5 million as part of the £11 million Horizon Europe/UKRI-funded project. This funding will be utilised to make public realm spaces more people-friendly and to enable vulnerable groups to become valued users of these spaces. The project aims to share its findings and learnings with European partners.

- January 2024 April 2025
- 32 project partners across Europe
- Led by the Links Foundation in Turin, Italy.

Just Streets - Delivery so far (1 of 2)

CRP has:

- Chosen Camden Town Unlimited, Harley Street BID and LB Lambeth for on-street solutions project
- Attended site visits and partner meetings in Amsterdam and Rotterdam (June 2024)
- Hosted the first online City Workshop in JS series, introducing London Delivery Partners and their interventions
- Participated in City Workshops in Kozani, Milan, and Braga
- Completed three out of five communication campaigns








Just Streets - Delivery so far (2 of 2) 🕢

Delivery Progress to Date includes:

- Camden Town Unlimited: Developing walking routes between Camden Town and King's Cross Station and creating a supporting lamppost signage system - Contract signed, Suppliers agreed, Co-creation sessions with stakeholders.
- Harley Street BID: Enhancing public spaces with improved seating and greenery - Contract signed, Internal review of public engagement findings, Installation site proposed (pending approval)
- LB Lambeth: Implementing school street at Macaulay Primary School, Clapham - Contract received, Co-creation sessions with stakeholders, Multiple site visits to existing school streets

Healthy Streets Everyday II (HSE II) - Overview

£1 million Mayor's Air Quality Fund project that will address the issue of over-dependence on private vehicles, and the associated issues of poor Air Quality, Environment, Safety, Health, and Wellbeing.

April 2024 - March 2027 14 project partners Led by CRP / Westminster City Council

Healthy Streets Everyday II (HSE II) - Delivery So Far 🕢

Following project delivery agreed with the GLA:

- Delivery of 3 Permanent School Streets to support safes spaces for children outside schools
- 10 new walking routes created to increase active travel
- 5 transport infrastructure improvements to encourage low emission travel.
- 12 communications campaigns to encourage transport behaviour change
- 1 public facing tool that will approximate Air Quality impacts of mode shift
- Delivery of 4,000 m2 green space/planting/rain gardens delivered across the existing street network, including in parking bays (pocket parks)

Delivery so far includes 7 school streets installed under temporary TMO's (we envisage 3 of these becoming permanent), 1 new walking route created, development of HSE II Map, 150 sq m of GI delivered and 1 communication campaign completed. We also organised a site visit to some of the HSE II schemes for Mete Coban Deputy Mayor for Environment and Energy.

- Installation of London delivery partners' solutions







Healthy Streets Everyday II (HSE II) - Expected Delivery Đ



- At least 1 more school street implemented
- The creation of 1 walking route across the HSE II partners
- The delivery of 1 low emission transport infrastructure e.g. shared cargo bike, mobility hub, across the HSE II partners
- 3 communication campaigns delivered by CRP promoting healthy streets, walking and cycling to encourage behaviour change
- 300 sq m of Greening installations in the Central District Alliance and South Bank BID / We Are Waterloo BID footprints.



Central London Sub-Regional Transport Partnership (CLSRTP)





CRP Fundraising Successes

- CRP is working on the basis that there MAY not be another Defra Air Quality Grant announced before well into 2025.
- CRP is diversifying its income streams by continuing to apply for European funding - we have already levered in 0.5m Euros for our JUST STREETS programme.
- CRP has also secured £1m Air Quality Funding from the Mayor of London.
- CRP is also working with a number of boroughs on their own micro logistics hub plans.
- 2024-25 CRP membership fees have been collected.
- CRP is also promoting its consultancy services proactively.
