## **Smarter Greener Logistics - October Update**



It's been a busy month for the CRP team, with updates right across the programme workstreams and all across London. This has included:

- Launching 2 new shared cargo bikes in the <u>London Borough of Islington</u> through the OurBike scheme.
- Sharing knowledge and learnings with 3 additional SGL Express Case Studies including <u>Parcel Locker Installations & Requirements</u> and <u>Air Quality and Noise</u> <u>Monitoring in Merton</u>. Read CRP's case studies <u>here</u>.
- Delivering another round of reporting for the <u>London Borough of Southwark</u> to understand the impact on cyclists and freight traffic of the recent installation of Cycleway 4 around Lower Road.

#### **OurBike Launches in Islington**



CRP are excited to announce that we have launched two new OurBike community cargo bikes in the <u>London Borough of Islington</u>.

<u>OurBike</u> is an app based community cargo bike share scheme. The new bikes are hosted by <u>Absolute Print</u> in Archway and <u>LC Cycleworx</u> in Nag's Head and can be used by businesses and residents at a subsidised rate for local deliveries, travelling with children or transporting larger items as a more sustainable transport mode.

CRP's cargo bike share interventions are part of <u>Smarter Greener Logistics (SGL)</u> a Defrafunded project led by <u>Westminster City Council</u> in collaboration with 25 project partners.

We are thrilled to see the progress of our <u>Horizon Europe</u> project, <u>Just Streets</u>, in London.

Over the past few months, our London delivery partners, <u>London Borough of Lambeth</u>, <u>Harley Street Business Improvement District</u>, and <u>Camden Town Unlimited</u> have made significant strides in implementing street interventions to create more equitable and safer streets.

Take the latter, for instance. Camden Town Unlimited is working to promote active travel in the bustling part of London by encouraging walking through "Heritage Trails" between Camden and King's Cross Station. They have engaged in several co-creation sessions with the public to gather diverse perspectives and ideas, including discussions on what the trails should encompass and what the wayfinding should entail.
