CRP's <u>Smarter Greener Logistics (SGL)</u> Programme has nearly been completed! In fact, we're currently in the process of preparing our Q7 report to Defra which will be submitted at the end of the month.

Over the past 3 months, CRP and our partners have:

- Completed a kerbside management trial of 8 virtual loading bays across London
- · Launched a cargo bike scheme in London Borough of Hackney
- Completed noise monitoring on Rotherhithe New Road in <u>London Borough of Southwark</u>.
- Published 2 new case studies

Healthier Streets in 2025



2024 saw the kick off of the <u>Healthy Streets Everyday II</u> (HSE II) programme, CRP's <u>Mayor's Air Quality Fund</u>ed 3-year programme.

Some of the outputs that have been delivered already include:

- 6 School Streets that have been installed, including 2 exemplar school streets
- 3 new walking routes
- Over 150 sq m of green space
- 3 resident focussed shared cargo bikes

Our partners on the programme will continue to deliver exciting improvements to London's streets, with upgrades to cycling infrastructure, walking routes, implementing school streets, creating low emission transport infrastructure and providing more green space.
