Built in 1846, this diagonal bridge helped horses tow barges west from Hampstead Lock. Cobbles gave hooves grip as they climbed the slope, Look for grooves in the handrail and stone parapet. They have been worn down by tow ropes, marking years of barge traffic and heavy loads along the canal.

Free Sunday Rides on Santander Cycles This August



Throughout August, Londoners can enjoy free unlimited 60-minute rides on Santander Cycles every Sunday as part of <u>TfL's Cycle Sundays</u> campaign.

Designed to support new and returning cyclists, the initiative features beginner-friendly routes through scenic areas such as Hyde Park, Primrose Hill, and Tower Hamlets, along with cycling tips and training guidance. Santander e-bikes must be hired via the Santander Cycles app or with a membership key and are only available to registered members, TfL added.

Rides longer than 60 minutes will incur standard additional charges. The initiative aims to make cycling more accessible, promote active travel, and encourage people of all experience levels to explore London by bike this summer.

Lambeth 10-Year Strategy



<u>London Borough of Lambeth</u> recently unveiled its ambitious <u>10-year Growth Plan (2025–2035)</u>, a bold blueprint to transform the borough into one of London's most inclusive, sustainable and innovative places to live, work and thrive.

The plan outlines four missions that will guide Lambeth's transformation over the next decade, focusing on revitalising town centres and infrastructure, growing key industries, creating new jobs and training opportunities, and building more affordable and sustainable homes.

The Growth Plan also aims to generate over £250 million from new developments, with funds reinvested directly into local projects, ensuring the benefits of growth are shared across the borough.

Lambeth is ready to lead the way on London's next chapter.

Healthy Air Coalition Publish Policy Blueprint Report



The <u>Healthy Air Coalition</u> has published a new blueprint calling for urgent, coordinated action across government departments to tackle air pollution and secure the right to clean air for all. Key recommendations include calls for a comprehensive Clean Air Act, legally binding targets aligned with WHO guidelines, as well as adequate funding and powers for local authorities.

The blueprint emphasises that tackling air pollution requires a comprehensive and integrated approach addressing emissions both outdoors and indoors, while prioritising environmental justice by ensuring cleaner air for vulnerable and marginalised communities disproportionately impacted by pollution.

CRP continues to support the mission to reduce London's air pollution and protect the health of Londoners through it's various initiative and programmes. CRP's <u>Mayor of London</u> funded <u>Healthy Streets Everyday II</u> programme is achieving this through the delivery of further walking routes, school streets, low emission transport infrastructure, and green infrastructure.
